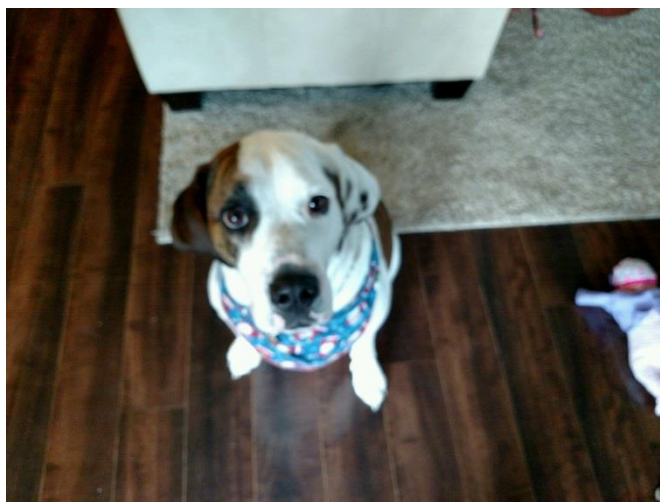


# Chubbs
